

Role of local authorities in Cohesion Policy

Local authorities in the partnership principle:

"The Member State shall involve <u>regional</u>, <u>local</u>, <u>urban</u> and other <u>public authorities</u> in:

- Preparation of Partnership Agreement
- Preparation of Programmes"

Local authorities in the principle of multi-level governance:

Bottom-up approach

"The Commission shall consult organisations which represent partners at Union level on the implementation of programmes, and shall report to the European Parliament and Council on the outcome"

Role of local authorities in Cohesion Policy

Local authorities in the partnership principle:

"The principle of partnership is a key feature in the **implementation** of the Funds, building on the multi-level governance approach and ensuring the involvement of regional, **local**, urban and other public authorities, civil society, economic and social partners and, where appropriate, research organisations and universities."

Local authorities' actions


- Working with the involved municipalities on the topic of tourism and energy
